- Listen to Finnish/Swedish music, podcasts, etc.
- Through friends, random encounters and at school
- Adult education centers (<u>Alma</u>), Higher Education Institutions and open universities offer variety of Finnish/Swedish courses. <u>SIMHE (University of</u> <u>Vaasa)</u> offers also language courses free of charge.
- Third sector voluntary activities, such as <u>Luetaan yhdessä</u> online/onsite courses and other language cafés
- Mentoring programmes by various organizers (SIMHE/Auroras for highly educated immigrant women, Womento Mentoring by Väestöliitto)

 - Prepare your marketing strategy

 - Finding a job is easier if you are familiar with the labour market
 - Find out which sectors and companies are offering work now and in the future
